Acceptable Chromebook and Internet Use Policy

1. The use of the Internet is a privilege, not a right, and inappropriate use will result in a cancellation of those privileges. Such inappropriate conduct may include, but not be limited to:

- Placing unlawful information, Chromebook viruses or harmful programs on the Chromebook systems in either public or private files or messages.
- Searching and finding pornographic, vulgar, obscene, or defamatory material.
- The unauthorized altering of system software.
- Intentionally seeking information on, obtaining copies of, or modifying files, other data, or passwords belonging to other users.
- Malicious use of the network through hate mail, harassment, profanity, vulgar statements, or discriminatory remarks.
- Copying of materials which would constitute a violation of copyright law. Such as Songs/music or games
- The use of obscene, vulgar, threatening, abusive, defamatory or otherwise objectionable language in sending messages.
- Use for commercial activities, purchase of products, product advertisement, or political lobbying.
- Violating federal, state or local, or criminal law.
- The misuse of 800 and 900 telephone numbers.

2) I shall not tamper, in any way, with any equipment or modify the system. I realize that if I am found responsible for damaging any equipment, I may lose my privileges and may also be held financially responsible for the repair or replacement of damaged equipment or software as determined by Akron Digital Academy. My privileges to use the network may be revoked. All stolen or damaged equipment must be reported immediately to the Akron Digital Academy.

3) The Chromebook and network is for educational purposes only. Akron Digital Academy is not responsible for the student's personal files. Personal files should be kept on personal storage devices, such as flash drives, floppies, or cd-roms.

4) Students, and if needed, student's parent/guardian may be asked to provide new or additional information about the student's account or to complete a new policy application, in the case of changes in laws, district policies, or new technology.

5) Student must use their own name and identity, using false identities may result in access being revoked and can be punishable by law.

6) Network and Internet electronic mail (e-mail) and other forms of electronic communication are subject to the Ohio Public Records Act (ORC 149.43) and as such are open to inspection by the public.

7) I understand that Akron Digital Academy provides access to the internet, but is not responsible for or endorse all the content that can be accessed.

8) Akron Digital Academy makes no warranties of any kind, either expressed or implied, in connection with its provision of access to and use of its networks and internet. Akron Digital

Academy shall not be responsible for any claims, losses, damages, or costs(including attorneys fees) of any kind, directly or indirectly, by any user or his parent/guardian arising out of the use of its networks or internet access.

9) ALL students are required to sign a student agreement form. Students under the age of 18, must have a Parental/guardian form signed by their parent or guardian taking responsibility of the students conduct and use of network and internet. Students over the age of 18 do not require parental/guardian consent, but are still responsible for their actions in regard to this policy.

10) Misuse of the Chromebook, network, and internet may result in immediate restoration of the Chromebook system, as determined by Akron Digital Academy.

11) Students who withdraw, are expelled, or leave Akron Digital Academy must return all tools and equipment to Akron Digital within 10 days of none attendance.

12) Students and Parent(s)/Guardian(s) must sign the Notice of Financial Responsibility in order to protect the Assets of Akron Digital.

Notice of Financial Responsibility

As part of Akron Digital Academy each student is provided with a Chromebook system. In addition, students may be provided with textbooks and additional software, school supplies, or Chromebook accessories for use while enrolled in Akron Digital Academy. This equipment and additional supplies are the property of the State of Ohio, purchased by Akron Digital Academy and are assigned to you, the student and/or the parent/guardian for use while enrolled in Akron Digital.

Student and Parent or Guardian are not to add, delete, alter, or load unapproved software, add additional hardware, or reconfigure any component issued by Akron Digital Academy. This equipment and software provide your “school environment” and any changes could affect the equipments capabilities or the educational process provided.

All repairs to this equipment will be provided directly by Akron Digital Academy. Attempting to repair equipment yourself or contracting a 3rd party repair company will make you financially responsible for damaged equipment.

Students that withdraw, are expelled, or discontinue service from the Akron Digital Academy are responsible for the return of loaned equipment and supplies within 10 business days of discontinued service.

*If student(s) fails to return the Chromebook and its’ equipment to Akron Digital Academy upon withdrawal, expulsion, or discontinued educational services from Akron Digital Academy, the parent/guardian or responsible parties, will be responsible for repayment of the Chromebook and its’ equipment not to exceed \$250.00.

Fee Menu:

- Broken, cracked or damaged screen: \$50.00
- Lost and/or Stolen Chromebooks and its’ equipment WILL be subject to the \$250.00 replacement cost (stolen Chromebooks MUST be reported to the local police authorities, and the police report forwarded to Akron Digital Academy for proof of theft).
- All other damages will be assessed for repair or replacement, not to exceed \$250.00.

OPTIONAL: Equipment should be insured in the amount of \$250 while in your possession. Contact your insurance agent and have the equipment added to your homeowners or rental insurance policy. Coverage should include at least fire, lightning, theft, and extended coverage.

In order for a student to receive the Chromebook for educational use while enrolled at Akron Digital Academy they must adhere to the following procedures:

- Students must successfully complete student orientation of the scheduled eight (8) consecutive days.
- If there is a break and or gap in the student’s orientation due to an absence, it must be excused with proper documentation.
- If a student must miss in excess of two (2) days of orientation, they must make up those days on within the scheduled two (2) week orientation.

- Students must complete one (1) consecutive week of classroom attendance after completion of orientation.
- Parent/Guardian or responsible party must be present to pick up the Chromebook and its' equipment.
- Government issued and/ or proper identification is required to pick up the Chromebook and its' equipment.
