



## Akron Digital Academy

Akron Digital Academy is a **NOT FOR PROFIT** community e-school located in Akron, Ohio. ADA students are from diverse populations and many are economically disadvantaged. Frequently, ADA students are nontraditional students who require differentiated instruction/services.

ADA strives to meet learners where they are and get them to where they need to be. Students receive a chromebook so that they can access their online studies and coursework 24/7. In addition to the online curriculum, students have the opportunity to meet face to face with highly qualified licensed teachers to support and enhance their online experience.

Credit recovery is an educational strategy designed to give high school students who have failed the opportunity to redo coursework or retake a course through alternate means. ADA offers credit recovery to students who may have lost hope of ever attaining a high school diploma.

ADA provides support services that help students and families address both academic and non-academic barriers to learning. Positive learning conditions increase students' chances of success. A linkage coordinator and community engagement coordinator assist students and families in connecting with local social services to promote healthy pathways to learning.

Flexible scheduling allows students to pursue an education on their terms/needs. Students can work from home, attend computer labs, participate in tutoring, or receive support services five days a week.
